



1. Each team may submit up to two (2) Team Sheets.
2. Each Team Sheet may consist of no more than five (5) different riders
3. Each Team Sheet must include at least one rider competing at a Novice or Intern – the fifth "optional" rider **must** be a girl.
mediate level.
4. You may use the same rider on two (2) different Team Sheets, but they must be competing in different classes — Class,
Cruiser, or Open.
5. You must designate the class you are using for each rider.
6. Only riders listed on your team roster can compete for your team.
7. A rider may compete for only one (1) team at the Games.
8. Your team entry must be turned in **before** the moto sheets are posted. No entries will be accepted after motos are posted.
9. The team with the most points at the end of the race is the winner.
10. Ties will be broken in the following manner to determine a winner:
 - It will be based on which teams riders qualified earliest:
 - ?Qualified 1st moto 1 point
 - ?Qualified 2nd moto 2 points
 - ?Qualified 3rd moto 3 points
 - Lowest points are the winner of the tie. Total point races will be calculated by a rider's finish in the motos. If a tie still exists, a coin toss will determine a winner
11. Rider team score points are awarded based on the following table (all classes score the same points):
